599 HHS ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY POLICY

1. This policy applies to all students in all extra curriculum activities (arts, athletics, FFA, etc.)
2. Grades 7-12 students may not have an F during any of the grade checks throughout the course of their season. Grade checks will occur four times a quarter at the end of the 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th weeks (or end of quarter if not the 9th week). Grades checks will occur on Friday and ineligible students will miss the following Monday-Sunday. Following one week of ineligibility, the student may begin to participate as long as the student is passing all courses, this includes homeroom. Students who continue to have one F will be ineligible for another week. It is the responsibility of the athletic director for checking and communicating with coaches, supervisors, and teachers for ineligible students.

1. Students receiving an incomplete will be declared ineligible for extracurricular activities until the incomplete is removed.
2. Students are expected to practice during the ineligible period.

Students who participate in Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) activities must also abide by the league rules.
